It would be impossible to list all 49 artists and 24 locations participating in the **Mundaring Hills Open Studios**, but consider this a little teaser of what to expect!

Starting in the foothills, painter the **Stacy Gardoll** will be showcasing her stunning contemporary realist botanicals and landscapes with high contrast and saturated colours at **Stacy Gardoll Art**, 16 Fordham Drive, Swan View.

Log Cabin Art at 215 Rycroft Road Darlington is home to the sculpture and woodwork of **Ian Kay** and glass art and mixed media by **Belinda Kay**. It will also feature ceramics from **Trudy Hardman**, inspired by local flora and fauna. Nearby at 23 Allpike Road, Darlington is the studio of at **Gemma Ben-Ary**, a visual artist who focuses on feminist theory, ecofeminism, and contemporary craft.

In Glen Forrest, **Neil Elliott**, a multi-award-winning Perth hills based painter and sculptor, will be able to talk you through his mixed media work drawn from history, engineering, his dreams and the many interesting objects found in his studio. He will be joined by **Kevin Norris**, a Darlington photographer who captures what he describes as a "global village", travelling the world to seek what makes people different yet similar. 12 Springside Crescent, Glen Forrest.

The ever-popular **White Peacock Studios** have several artists in residence, including globally-inspired ceramic artist and studio creator **Deanne Parker**, **Greg Crowe**, the well-known woodfired and salt glazed pottery specialist and the extremely gifted and renowned contemporary artist **William Boissenvain**. White Peacock Studios, Lot 102 Glenburn Rd, Glen Forrest.

Debuting this year is painter **Louise Thorpe**, a figurative artist who experiments with oils, acrylic, charcoal and mixed media in her recycled studio on the edge of the forest at 620 Charles Road, Mahogany Creek. Award-winning glass artist returns **Silvania Ferrario's** work can be viewed just around the corner at her studio **Siju Glass**, located at 2790 Thomas Road.
